iPad Usage Fee for 2023-2024 school year

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Students in grades K-12 will be issued personal iPads in protective keyboard cases for use in school and at home. Local Bus & Technology tax bonds that cover the expense of hardware have continued to pass every 3-4 years in our community. However, expenses such as insurance, software, and administration require additional funding that is not covered by bonds. So, annually we ask for a \$25 fee to help cover some of these costs.

The fee is \$25, payable in cash or check to Leland Public school.

If your family is in need this fee may be waived - guidelines are on the back of this page.

Please note that in addition each student and a parent/guardian must also fill out and agree to our Technology Acceptable Use Policy document to make use of iPads and the school network. The use policy also covers the fees for damages, repairs, and lost equipment. Please take the time to read and go over the Acceptable Use Policy and the Care Guidelines and Fee Schedule with your student.
